**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING
CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY ITEMS OF RECREATION
PROGRAM SURPLUS TO THE USES AND NEEDS OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION**

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously considered budgeting and operations of the Parks and Recreation services of the City of Sunnyside, and has found that current financial status of the City does not allow for continued operation of all recreation programs in the City and in City parks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the City of Sunnyside owns and maintains sports and recreation equipment which are not being used for the benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the community would benefit from the availability and use of such sports and recreation equipment by sports leagues and other nonprofit entities providing sports and recreation services for the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that, given financial constraints, it cannot implement a full recreation program for its residents for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the City Manager's assessment that the value of the recreational equipment owned and maintained by the City of Sunnyside exceeds \$2,500 in value, but is less than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the recreational and sports equipment stored in the storage rooms of City Hall is surplus to the uses and

needs of the City of Sunnyside, and should be declared surplus, with disposition authorized by any means deemed appropriate under state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such declaration and disposition of property is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the recreational and sports equipment and materials located in storage at the Sunnyside City Hall are hereby declared to be surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of such property by any means allowable pursuant to state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code, including but not limited to, solicitation of sealed bids from qualified bidders who, as a condition of bid, are nonprofit organizations which will use such equipment to provide recreational and sports opportunities in the City of Sunnyside for youth and adults.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
