**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATION
(Washington Traffic Safety Commission Program)**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that funding of traffic safety programs in conjunction with law enforcement programs and functions is a high priority to promote the health, safety and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC) has invited applications for grant funding through the "Target Zero Task Force Project;" and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has prepared an application for grant funding through such Program; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that submission of such application is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes preparation and submission of an application for grant funding through the Target Zero Task Force Project offered through the Washington Traffic Safety Commission; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and submit such application for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside, and to prepare, execute and administer all documents and reports necessary or appropriate to accomplish the purposes of such grant and application.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
