**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING COMMUNICATION OF
COUNCIL'S COMMITMENT TO CONTINUE PARTICIPATION IN
THE REGIONAL STORMWATER PLANNING GROUP
WITH YAKIMA COUNTY, CITY OF YAKIMA,
CITY OF UNION GAP, AND CITY OF SUNNYSIDE
(Regional Stormwater Policy Group)**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously entered into an intergovernmental stormwater agreement with Yakima County and the Cities of Yakima and Union Gap, for the purposes of cooperatively achieving and maintaining compliance with the terms, conditions and provisions of the State of Washington's Eastern Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater General permit (NPDES Phase II); and

WHEREAS, the parties to the previous agreement are developing a successor Intergovernmental Agreement for cooperative efforts to comply with the remaining provisions of the NPDES Phase II Permit; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Stormwater Planning Group (RSPG) has requested that its members communicate their intention and commitment to continue participation in the group; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that communication of such commitment to continue in the Regional Stormwater Planning Group is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to communicate in writing the intention and commitment of the City of Sunnyside to continue participation in the Regional Stormwater Planning Group.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
