RESOLUTION 2009 - 80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY
HELD BY POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of Sunnyside has found bicycles, and as a result, has several unclaimed items in accordance with RCW 63.21.050; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that the property listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and as hereafter described, is unclaimed in accordance with RCW 63.21.050 and should be disposed of, including transfer of all such items to the Sunnyside's Promise Lucky 7 Bike youth program or other charitable youth organizations qualified for tax-exempt status under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3) of the federal internal revenue code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such actions as authorized herein are in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. That the property listed and described in Exhibit "A" is unclaimed in accordance with RCW 63.21.050; and the Police Chief is hereby authorized to dispose of such unclaimed property in any manner deemed lawful and in the best interests of the City of Sunnyside, including transfer of all such items to the Sunnyside's Promise Lucky 7 Bike youth program or other charitable youth organizations qualified for tax-exempt status under 26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3) of the federal internal revenue code, provided that any nonprofit charitable organization receiving such personal property must use the property, or its proceeds, to benefit needy persons.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
