**RESOLUTION 2009 - 87**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,  
IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSITION NO. 1 YAKIMA COUNTY  
LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Yakima County Commissioners have placed on the November 3, 2009 election ballot Proposition No. 1, Local Sales and use Tax for Criminal Justice Services, regarding the continuation of a sales and use tax equal to three-tenths of one percent (0.3%) to provide funds for the Sheriffs Office, local police departments and other public safety and criminal justice services; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has received approximately \$280,000 annually from this sales tax; and,

**WHEREAS**, these dollars are currently used to fund four (4) Police Officers for the Sunnyside Police Department, and other criminal justice services; and,


**WHEREAS**, these funds are vital to the City in helping to provide important law enforcement services to the residents of our community; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby endorses Proposition No. 1 Yakima County Local Sales and Use Tax for Criminal Justice Services and urges voters to support this ballot measure in order to continue funding for these important law enforcement services in the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall be effective upon passage and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
