POST PERMIT IN CONSPICUOUS PLACE AT SALE LOCATION

9.34.020 Billposting. It is unlawful for any person to post, stick, stamp, paint or otherwise affix, or cause the same to be done by any person, any notice, placard, bill, card, poster, advertisement or other paper or device, calculated to attract the attention of the public, to or upon any sidewalk, crosswalk, curb or curbstone, or any other portion or part of any public way or public place, or any lamp post, light, posser, telegraph or telephone pole, or any hydrant, box or fixture of the fire alarm or police communication system, or other public structure or building, or on any private wall, fence, building or other private property without the consent of the owners or person in control thereof. CHAPTER 5.13 - SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE

5.18.010 Yard Sales Defined. Yard sales, rummage sales, attic sales and other similar terms, except flea market, refer to the sale of used articles on the private property of one of the sellers.

5.18.020 Restrictions. Yard sales will be permitted in residential and other zones as permitted in the zoning code, but are limited to three (3) consecutive days in length per sale. There will be a limit of four (4) yard sales at any one location in a calendar year and said sale will be on the premises of one of the parties selling articles. No portion of any property will be rented or leased for the purpose of holding a year sale.

5.12.030 Permit Required. A. It is unlawful to conduct any yard sale without first obtaining a permit from the Sunnyside Police Department.

5. 18.040 Exception – Non Profit Organizations. Local non-profit organizations whose members reside in Yakima County are exempt from the provisions of Section 5.18.020, but must obtain a permit.

5.18.050 Violation – Penalty. A. Any person violating this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars. B. A person is guilty of a separate offense for each day during which he commits or continues a violation of this chapter.
